## Lafayette Master Plan Update

The vision statement for Lafayette's comprehensive plan got full approval of the consolidated council but that didn't come without some concerns.

Tuesday night the council agreed to endorse the statement, but there were some questions. LCG President Joey Durel reminded the council that the vision statement represents what the people want for the future of Lafayette. He says look at it as the goal that

maps out the route for the comprehensive plan.

One councilman expressed his concern that the vision statement doesn't address infrastructure.

"Do you want a good future for Lafayette or do you not? It's a dream right now. I appreciate the fact that you're dreaming for the stars rather than something a lot lower" said Durel.

"I saw nothing but quality of life issue addressed. I didn't see anything about core infrastructure. Mr. Bertrand eluded to the speeding, the clean water. I saw none of that in the vision statement. These are things that need to be addressed and where are we going to pay for it. Where is the money going to come from?" said Andy Naquin.

Durel says more public meetings will be held in the near future.
