All starting times, except for the first game of the day, are approximate and are subject to change. Please have your team at the field at least thirty (30) minutes prior to your game. All games will be played at Foster Park. The Team listed first for each game will be first on Offense for each game. There will be concessions at the jamboree so no outside food or drinks will be allowed inside the stadium, with the lone exception being large, single water and/or ammonia water containers for the team. The admission charges will be \$3 per Adult and \$2 per child, aged 6-16. The maximum amount charged to a family will be \$10. Each parent is encouraged to bring chairs for seating purposes. JAMBOREE RULES

- 1) All games will consist of one (1) forty (40) minute running time half.
- 2) The clock will stop for timeouts and injuries only.
- 3) Each team will receive two (2) timeouts per game.
- 4) There will be no kicking game during the jamborees.
- 5) There will be no extra points attempted during the jamborees.
- 6) When starting a possession the offense will begin on its 20-yard line, except after a safety.
(Unless field length dictates otherwise)
- 7) Any rule not specifically covered above will be taken directly from the High School rulebook with all LRPD exceptions included.
- 8) There will be no punts. The ball will be moved 25 yards, but not inside the 20-yard line.
