BASKETBALL INFORMATION SHEET - TEENER LEAGUE

ELIGIBILITY

1. In Teener League play participants must be attending a Lafayette Parish or Parochial High School or be a high school student who lives in Lafayette Parish to be eligible. College students, high school drop-outs, regardless of age, are not eligible for this program. High school graduates are not eligible for this program unless they graduated after the start of the 2009-10 academic year. A player cannot be 19 before December 31, 2009.

2. Each team roster is limited to 15 players. Rosters must be turned in at the coaches/managers meeting, February, 18.

3. A player may play for only one team in the program. There will be no transferring to other teams except with the permission of the program director.

4. Any member of a school's **Varsity, Junior Varsity or Freshman Team** is ineligible for the entire season. They cannot be added if they are removed from, quit the school team or the school team's season ends.

5. All players must have a pictured school I.D. or Driver's License to be eligible to play. I.D.'s must be presented **before the start of each game.**

6. Team registration fees will be \$125.00 per team. Team fees must be paid by Friday, February 12, 2010. Registration card must be turned in with the fee. **The team coaches/managers must be an adult and must be present at all games. This adult must be a parent or an approved coach by the LRPD.**

TEAM NAMES

Team names will be school names, school mascots, collegiate mascots or professional mascots. Sponsor names must be cleared by the Program Coordinator.
All team names will be screened by the Department.

PLAYER EQUIPMENT

Players on a team **must wear similarly colored jerseys with numbers on the back or front.** Names, if printed on shirts, must be either player's name or team name. **NO NICKNAMES.** Teams having inappropriate names on their uniforms will automatically forfeit their game scheduled to be played that night and every game thereafter using the uniform with said name. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

PLAYING RULES

Official High School rules will be use with a few minor LRPD exceptions.

PLAY

Games will be played week nights (mostly Mondays, Wednesdays and/or Thursdays) at various LRPD locations. Teams may have one or two games scheduled per week. Playoffs will be single elimination. The number of teams making the playoffs will depend on the number of teams in the program.
