




# Five year Comparison-total response




# 2013 Type of Alarm responses




# 2013 Fire incident type



# Fire Incident Type comparison




# Five year analysis-structure fires




# Dollar Value Saved & loss analysis



# 2013 property use of responses




# Property type and building fires



## Communications

*Assuring adequate and timely responses to emergencies*

- ❖ 7,773 City dispatches
- ❖ 3,330 Parish dispatches
- ❖ Expedient - >95% w/in 15 sec.
- ❖ Networking with 911 and other emergency dispatch centers
- ❖ Enhancing communication equipment
- ❖ Updating street maps
- ❖ Assisting in administrative duties



# L. F. Babin Institute of Fire Training

## Training

*Providing innovative and quality training to assure professional, safe, and efficient service*

- ❖ 5,310 training hours
- ❖ PIAL required training (15 courses)
- ❖ First responder
- ❖ 96<sup>th</sup> and 97<sup>th</sup> Recruit Academy (27 new firefighters)
- ❖ Confined space, SCBA maze, OJT, Forcible entry, Legal aspects, etc.
- ❖ Department-wide Health Screening
- ❖ Volunteer training
- ❖ Outside agencies



# Fire Prevention

*Safeguarding emergency personnel, residents, and visitors with effective and efficient code enforcement and fire education*

- ❖ 679 Certificate of Occupancy issued
- ❖ 1,910 inspections (113 complaints)
- ❖ Public education to 8,524 residents
- ❖ 163 investigation (33 arsons/2 fatalities)
