
# Neighborhood Profile | Freetown Port-Rico

### People Population Growth

- In 2010, Freetown Port-Rico had 2,722 residents, which is about 2% of Lafayette's population.
- Freetown Port-Rico's population increased by 59% from 2000 to 2010, while the city grew by about 9% in the same time frame.

### Diversity


- Freetown Port-Rico's population is about 58% white and 37% black.
- Lafayette's population, by comparison, is 64% white and 31% black.

- The majority of jobs by industry in Freetown Port-Rico fall into the categories of services (67%) and retail (16%).
- When broken down by occupation, Freetown Port-Rico's population is 45% white collar, 35% services, and 21% blue collar.

• In 2019, the median household income in Freetown Port-Rico was \$15,154, as compared to \$45,029 in Lafayette.



• 78% of Freetown Port-Rico's residents live in households, of which 30% are families.


#### **Median Home Value**
