

See attached description below for the additional work item that should be added for Amendment No. 3 as a Specification Special Condition. You should require a signature for Amendment No. 3 that the contractor acknowledges that includes this item at \$2.5M lump sum paid in partial payments as described below and also 1800 linear feet in silt fence for the additional quantity placed on the CIDC site. The attached pay estimate No. 3 would pay 50% of the \$2.5M for the "Demobilization, Relocation and Phasing Assimilation" work which is \$1.25M. The other mobilization item still remains open (as it has to since future pay estimates have to go through the state and we need to match our specifications with payout). As soon as he digs 330,000 cy of dirt it will put them at the 60% complete which on the original mobilization he will get an additional \$580,000 with that pay estimate. Once he finishes 80% he gets another 10% of the mobilization which is \$290K and then when he finishes the \$30M job he gets the remainder of the \$2.9M mobilization which is \$290K. Once the additional Phase II Capital Outlay funds are added and he completes 25% of that work he will start collecting the remainder of the "Demobilization, Relocation and Phasing Assimilation". So in total for all mobilization, etc. he will get \$5.4M. Typically mobilization runs about 5% on big jobs but as much as 8-10% on small jobs. So if the project goes to \$60M (Current \$30M plus additional \$20M from capital Outlay plus \$10M in matches and other funds) you will have paid 9% in mobilization total. If the project stops at the \$31.25M you will have paid \$4.15 M which is 12.9% in mobilization. Let me know your thoughts.

Work Item 727-01-00101 "Demobilization, Relocation and Phasing Assimilation" – The work covered under this work item shall include the demobilization, relocation and remobilization of equipment and materials and personnel to an additional project location per the direction of the owner or owner's representative as well as the bifurcation of equipment and personnel resources for construction within both the initial and secondary site. This work shall be applicable after mobilization of equipment and labor to initial project site is complete and work on initial site is greater than 40% complete at the time the contractor is directed to relocate by owner regardless of reason. Payment for work associated with this item shall be lump sum and include any and all costs of demobilization, relocation and bifurcation of equipment and labor resources between both sites, disruption of construction activities and any incidental downtime or delay costs due to land acquisition; court injunctions; utility relocations; additional phases; funding acquisition for additional phases. Payment for this work shall be made in partial payments in accordance with the table below. Payment shall not be adjusted beyond the identified lump sum in contract and/or amendment in the event of an overall adjusted contract price once additional funding is obtained and regardless of the number of project phases. The 2nd, 3rd and 4th partial payments shall only be paid during Phase II of the contract/project.

AMENDMENT NO. 3 to the CONTRACT - CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK

THIS AMENDMENT, made and entered into this ______ day of April, 2022 by and between the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, Lafayette, Louisiana, hereinafter called "LCG", and Rigid Constructors, LLC, hereinafter called the "Contractor."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS: The parties listed above entered into a contract on February 2, 2022 (the "Contract") for Construction Management at Risk services for the **Bayou Vermilion Flood Control Project**, hereinafter referred to as the "Project;" and

WHEREAS: LCG has secured funding for the construction of Phase 1 of the Project, as described in the Contract Documents, and the continuation of this Project after the completion of Phase 1 is contingent upon LCG receiving additional funding sufficient to pay for the subsequent Project phase(s); and

WHEREAS: The Owner wishes to acknowledge and establish the maximum participation of the Capital Outlay Grant Program to be \$26,525,000 for the GMP/Construction of the project and \$75,000 for Administration of the grant by Facility Planning and Control; and

WHEREAS: The Contract Documents provides for the establishment of a Guaranteed Maximum Price for the entire Project, with an allocation of the Guaranteed Maximum Price to Phase 1 and the subsequent, unfunded phase(s), through execution of a Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment, but the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment will initially add construction services for Phase 1 of the Project to the Contract only; and

WHEREAS: The Owner has already provided for the execution of Amendments 1 and 2 to the contract setting the GMP prior to plan completion to establish pay items for preliminary work; and

WHEREAS: The Owner seeks to amend the GMP to provide for amendments to the Contract Documents; and

WHEREAS: The Contract requires an additional item of work and amendments to others to consider for the demobilization at the Homewood site and mobilization to the Duhon Road site.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree to amend the Contract Documents as follows:

I.

Delete the Mobilization work item in the Standard Specification as written and replace with the following amended Mobilization work item due to the necessity too equitably account for+- above normal upfront costs being borne by the Contractor.

Work Item 727-01-00100 "Mobilization" — The work covered under this item consists of preparatory work and operations, including necessary movement of personnel, equipment, supplies, and incidentals to the project site; the establishment of offices, buildings, and other facilities necessary for work on the project; the cost of bonds and any required insurance; and other preconstruction expenses necessary for the start of work, excluding the cost of construction materials. The Owner recognizes that this particular project's pricing/cost structure for Mobilization includes significant preconstruction costs above and beyond normal and customary costs in order for significant savings associated with the excavation costs to materialize. 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The following Special Provision is added to the Contract Documents:

Work Item 203-02-00108 "Limited Excavation (Long Haul (> 1 mile one way) – Off Road)" – The work covered under this work item shall be performed in general accordance with Section 203 of the standard specifications. The limits and general configuration and depth is shown on the plans and a points file may be requested from LCG's design consultant for the Contractor to layout and excavate the pond to the plan dimensions. A portion of the excavated material associated with the excavation of the ponds off Duhon Road may be stockpiled on private properties located adjacent to the project site as secured by contractor under separate agreements. Contractor shall follow all applicable codes and regulations when performing this work. AMENDMENT NO. 3 to the CONTRACT - CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK

THIS AMENDMENT, made and entered into this ______ day of April, 2022 by and between the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, Lafayette, Louisiana, hereinafter called "LCG", and Rigid Constructors, LLC, hereinafter called the "Contractor."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS: The parties listed above entered into a contract on February 2, 2022 (the "Contract") for Construction Management at Risk services for the **Bayou Vermilion Flood Control Project**, hereinafter referred to as the "Project;" and

WHEREAS: LCG has secured funding only for the construction of Phase 1 of the Project, as described in the Contract Documents, and the continuation of this Project after the completion of Phase 1 is contingent upon LCG receiving additional funding sufficient to pay for the subsequent Project phase(s); and

WHEREAS: The Owner wishes to acknowledge the maximum participation of the Capital Outlay Grant Program to be \$26,525,000 of the Guaranteed Maximum Price ("GMP") for construction of Phase 1 of the Project and \$75,000 for administration of the grant by Facility Planning and Control; and

WHEREAS: The GMP was established in the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment for Phase 1, entered into by the parties on March 23, 2022; and

WHEREAS: The Project will require the Contractor to demobilize at the Homewood site and mobilize at the Duhon Road site; and

WHEREAS: The parties desire to amend the Contract to add and amend work items and to amend the GMP to account for the changes in work items.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree to amend the Contract Documents as follows:

I.

Special Provisions, Section 727 is added to the Contract Documents:

SECTION 727 – MOBILIZATION

SUBSECTION 727.01 – DESCRIPTION

This subsection is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

727.01 - DESCRIPTION.

Work Item 727-01-00100 "Mobilization" - The work covered under this item consists of preparatory work and operations, including necessary movement of

personnel, equipment, supplies, and incidentals to the project site; the establishment of offices, buildings, and other facilities necessary for work on the project; the cost of bonds and any required insurance; and other preconstruction expenses necessary for the start of work, excluding the cost of construction materials. The Owner recognizes that this particular project's pricing/cost structure for Mobilization includes significant preconstruction costs above and beyond normal and customary costs in order for significant savings associated with the excavation costs to materialize.

Work Item 727-01-00101 "Demobilization, Relocation and Phasing Assimilation" - The work covered under this work item shall include the demobilization, relocation and remobilization of equipment and materials and personnel to an additional project location per the direction of the Owner as well as the bifurcation of equipment and personnel resources for construction within both the initial and secondary site. This work shall be applicable after mobilization of equipment and labor to the initial project site is complete and work on initial site is greater than 40% complete at the time the Contractor is directed to relocate by Owner regardless of reason. Payment for work associated with this item shall be lump sum and include any and all costs of demobilization, relocation and bifurcation of equipment and labor resources between both sites, disruption of construction activities and any incidental downtime or delay costs due to land acquisition; court injunctions; utility relocations; additional phases; funding acquisition for additional phases. Payment for this work shall be made in partial payments in accordance with Table 727-2 below. Payment shall not be adjusted beyond the identified lump sum in contract and/or amendment in the event of an overall adjusted contract price once additional funding is obtained and regardless of the number of project phases. The 2nd, 3rd and 4th partial payments shall only be paid during Phase II of the contract/project.

SECTION 203 – EXCAVATION AND EMBANKMENT

Add the following:

SUBSECTION 203.16 - LIMITED EXCAVATION.

Work Item 203-02-00108 "Limited Excavation (Long Haul (> 1 mile) — Off Road), Duhon Road Site" — The work covered under this work item shall be performed in general accordance with Section 203 of the standard specifications. The limits and general configuration and depth is shown on the plans and a points file may be requested from LCG's design consultant for the Contractor to layout and excavate the pond to the plan dimensions. A portion of the excavated material associated with the excavation of the ponds off Duhon Road may be stockpiled on private properties located adjacent to the project site as secured by contractor under separate agreements. Contractor shall follow all applicable codes and regulations when performing this work. It shall be the responsibility of the CMAR Contractor to work within conditions stipulated in agreement between property owner and contractor. LCG's design consultant to tract and document what portion of the excavation shall be relevant and falling under this item of work.

Measurement and payment of the work associated with the work item shall be measured in cubic yards of excavated material (net section) as defined by comparing the existing surface and an excavated surface compiled using a LiDAR generating surface from a drone flight. The design consultant or its subconsultant shall "fly" the area at predetermined dates for the development of monthly quantities. The unit price shall include but not limited to the necessary excavation; hauling the excavated material to adjacent properties in excess of 1 mile away from thee excavation site; the stockpiling of the excavated material; and the seeding and application of fertilizer on the entire disturbed area of the stockpile area. Hydro-

seeding and seeding of the pond area/limits, including the side slopes are included in other applicable items of work.

III.

All prior Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendments for Phase 1 are superseded by the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment for Phase 1 attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

Except as specifically modified herein, all other terms, covenants and conditions of the Contract Documents will continue in full force and effect.

WHEREAS: The parties entered into a contract on February 2, 2022 (the "Contract") for Construction Management at Risk services for the following construction project to be installed for the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, hereinafter referred to as the "Project;"

Bayou Vermilion Flood Control Project
